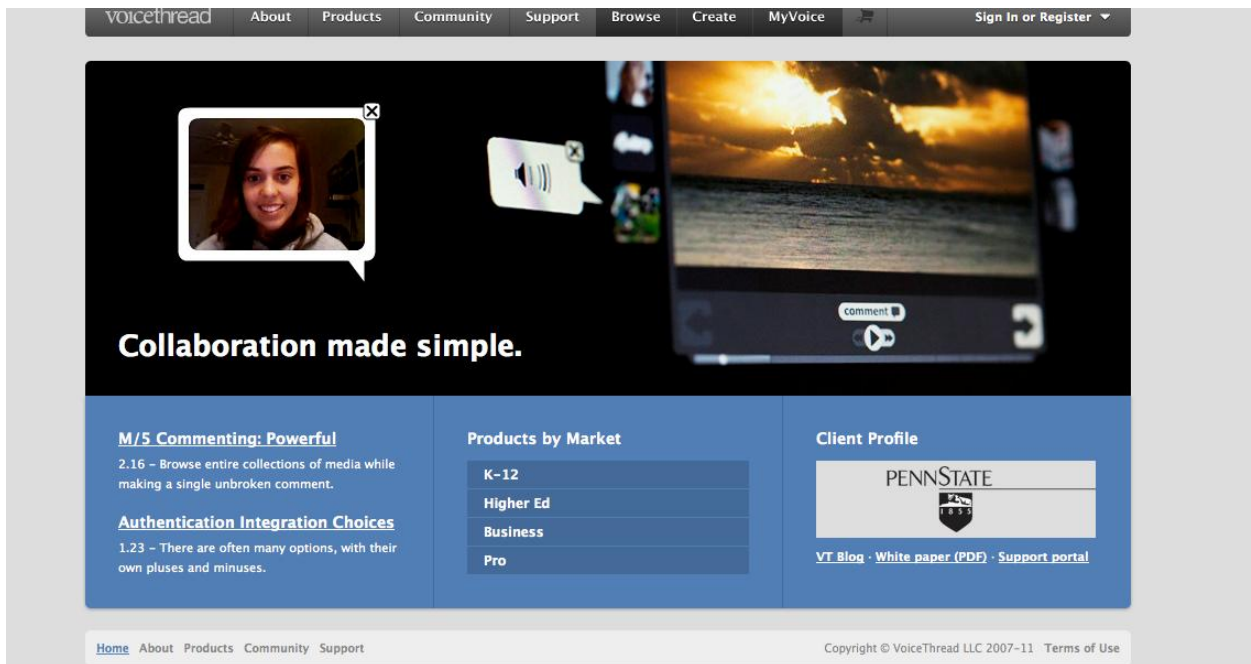


A Quick Guide to Using VoiceThread

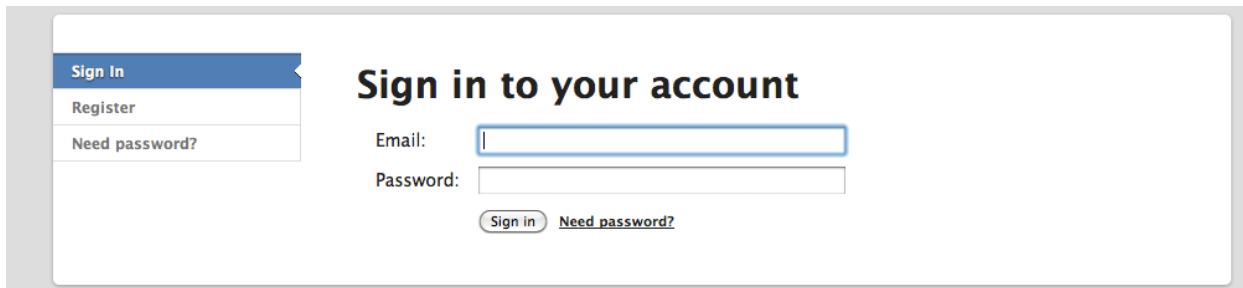
This guide will help you remember how to set up your Voicethread account and also how to share your recordings and listen to your classmates' recordings.

Setting up your Voicethread account

1. Go to Voicethread.com
2. Click on sign in or register



3. Please choose Register! in the box that opens



4. Type in the necessary information. You may use any e-mail address that you would like. Click register when you are done.

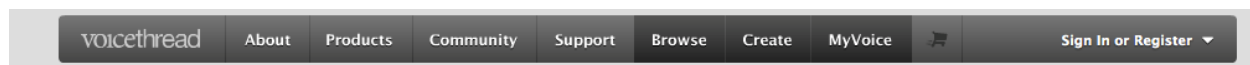

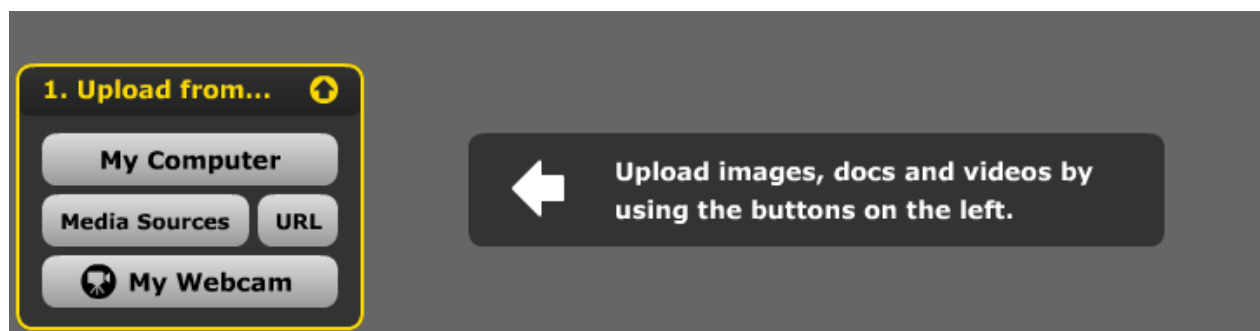
5. You now have a Voicethread account! Please remember the e-mail address and password that you used so that you can sign in again!

Making a Voicethread

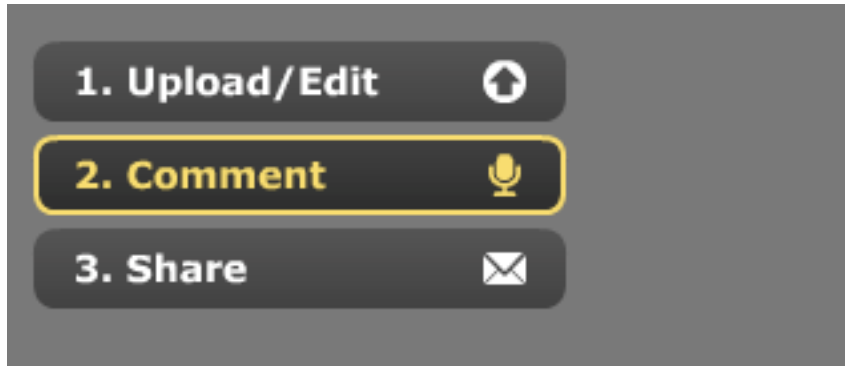
1. Choose create from the tabs on the home screen



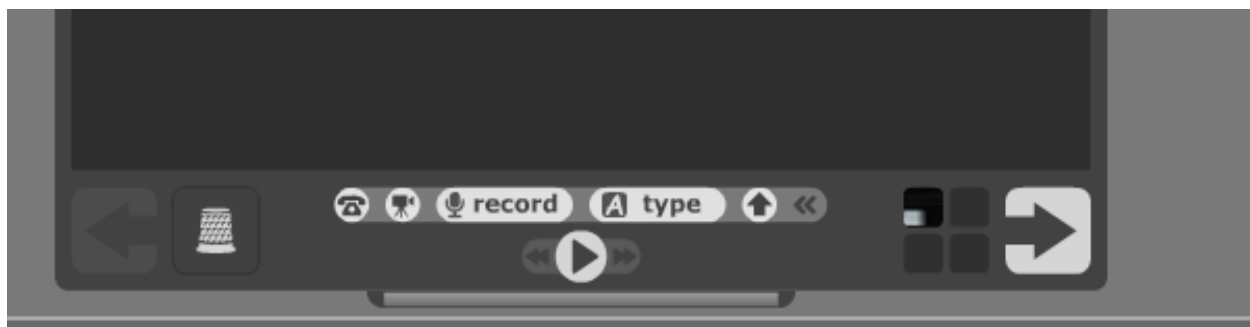
2. The first step is to upload a picture - you can upload anything you want. A picture of yourself or a picture of something you like might be a good idea.



3. Then choose the second step, comment. This is where you make a recording about whatever you want.

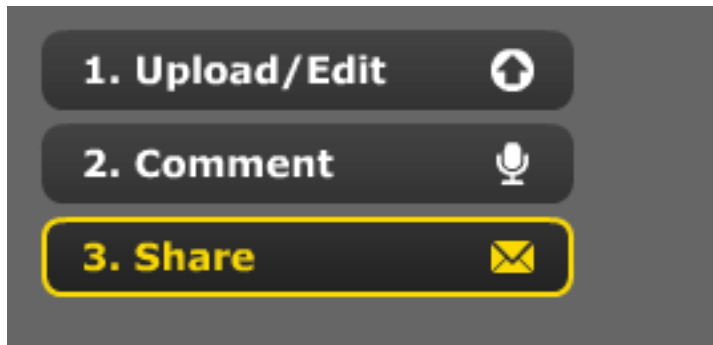


4. To record the comment, press comment and then record. The program will tell you when to start talking.

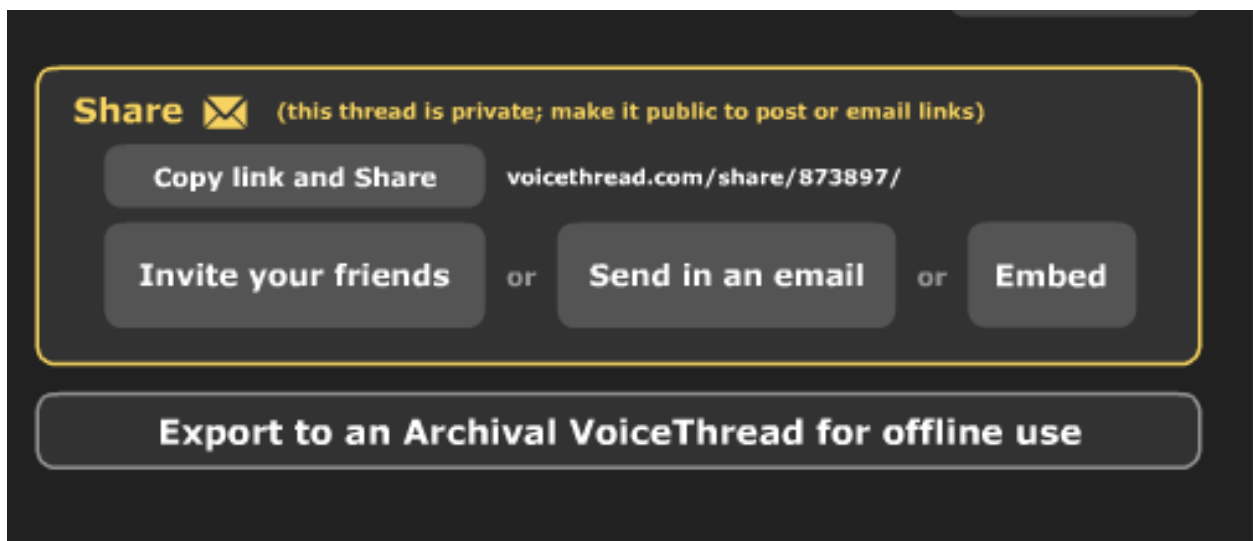


Sharing a Voicethread

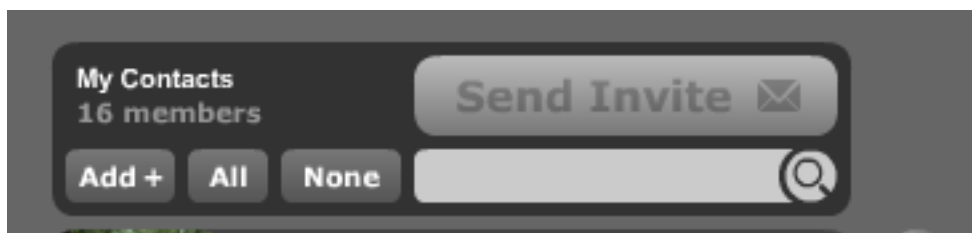
1. After you have recorded your Voicethread, click on the share button




2. You can also share directly from the recording - the easiest way to share is to click on the button that says "Invite your friends" or you can also send an email.



3. Either way, you need to add the person as a friend




4. Type the e-mail address and the person's name, then click add



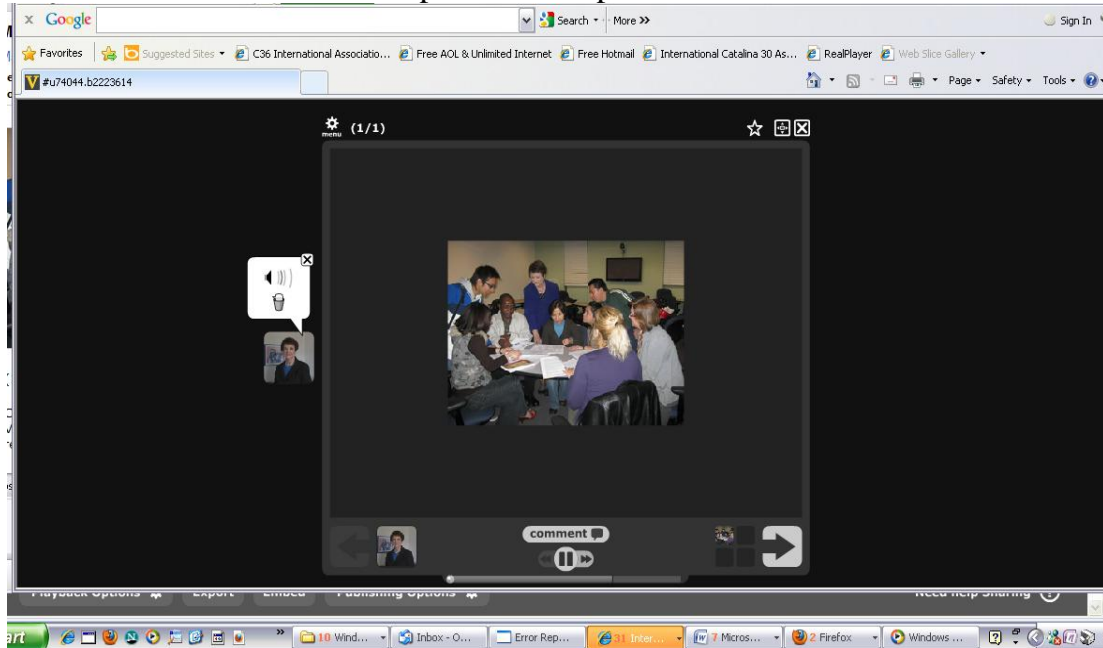
